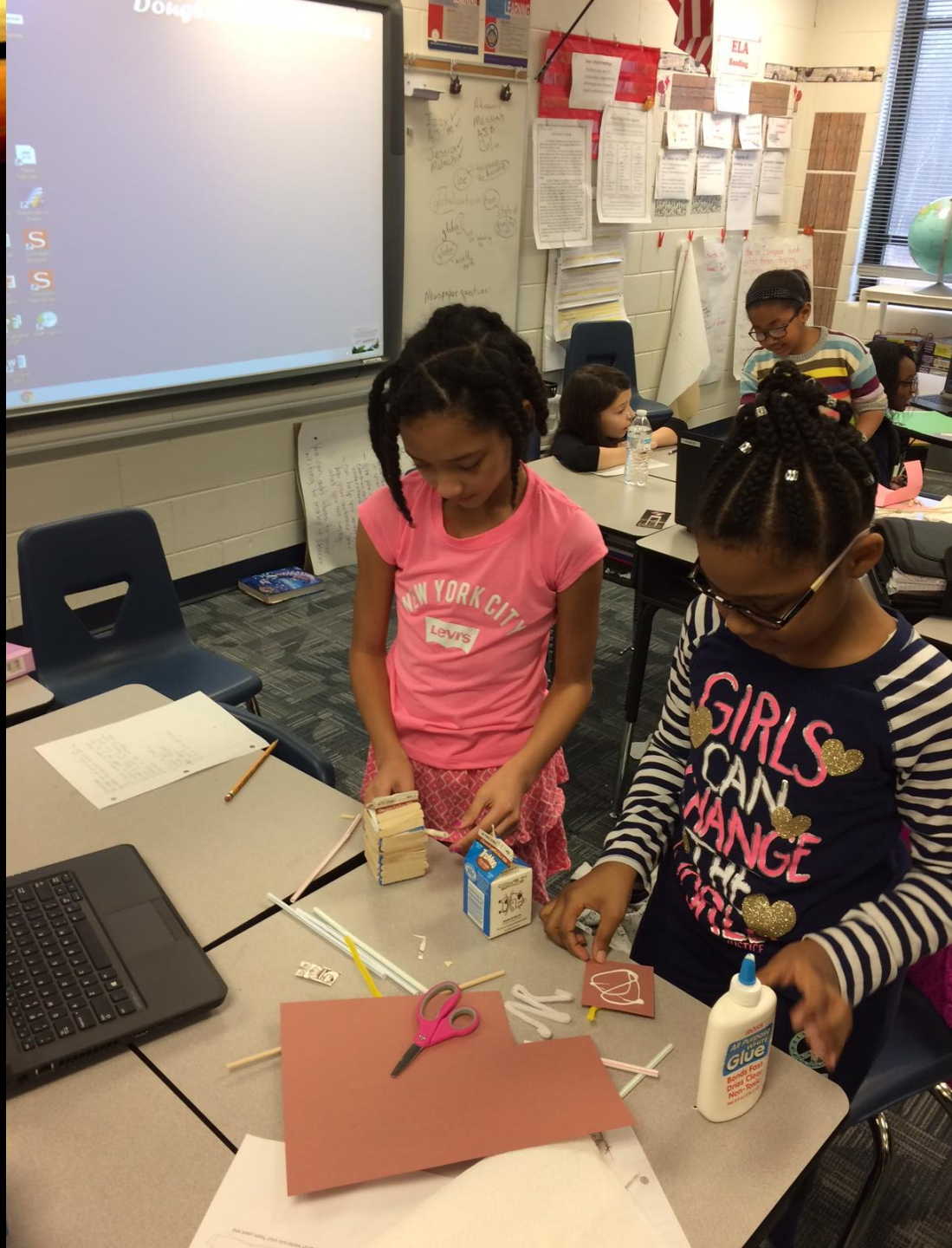


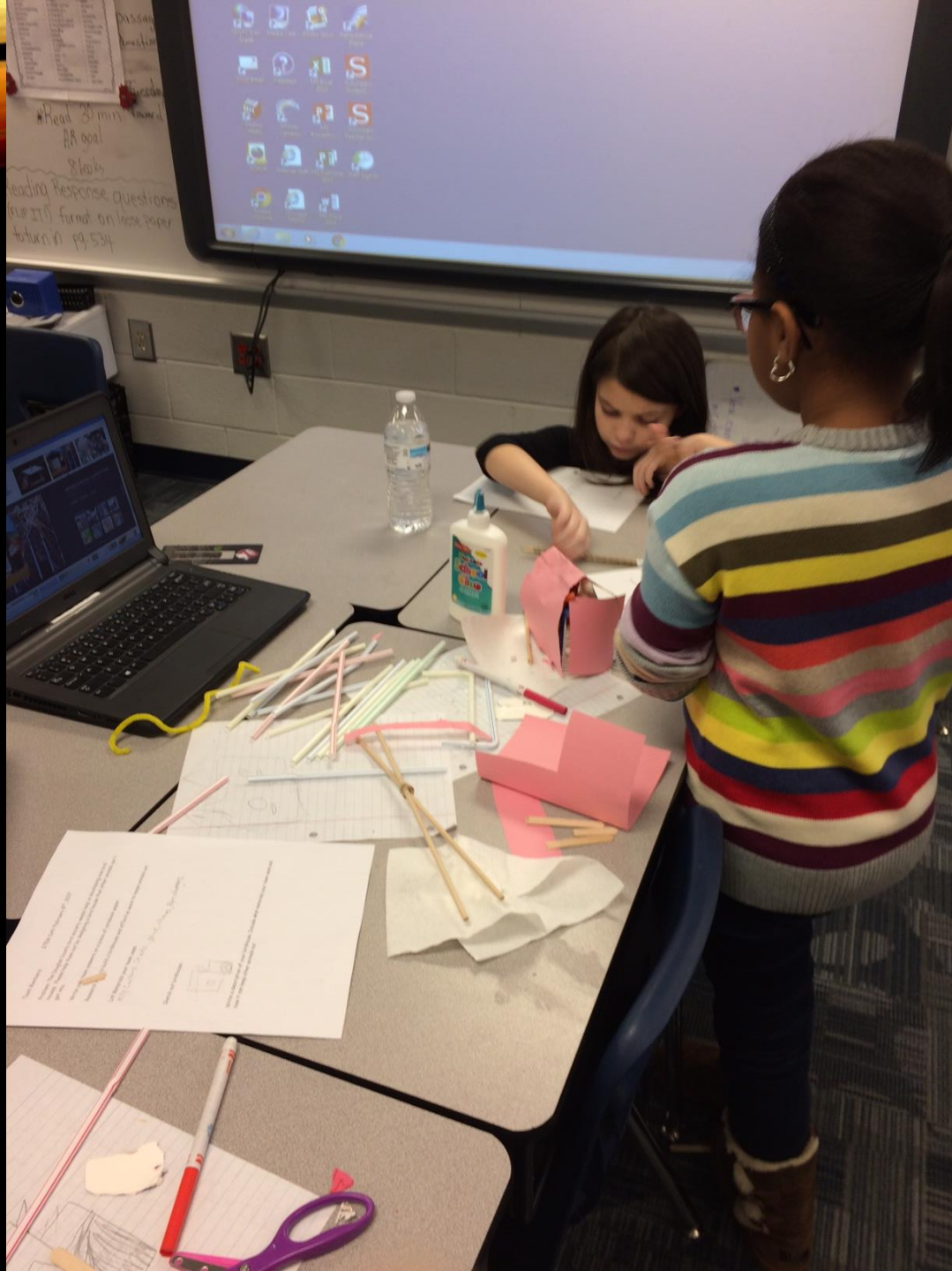














My Bird House
